

# poetry CD COVER project

You will create a CD jacket as if you are a musician. The project, which you will create in Microsoft Publisher, will consist of:

## **FRONT COVER:**

1. A one or two-word album title (ex. Cupcakes, Blue Surfboard, BFF, Anxiety, Ziploc Bag)  
Think about a hobby, place, item or animal in nature, emotion, something that amuses you.
2. A concrete poem that represents that title (You will write and illustrate your concrete poem on a square piece of unlined paper, which Mrs. Trial will scan for you.)

## **INSIDE LEFT:**

1. A photograph either from the Internet or that you take. It should match the overall concept of your album.
2. Song “lyrics” superimposed on top of the image. These lyrics are actually an original poem you will write to match one of your song titles.
  - \* The poem should be a *minimum* of 3 stanzas of 5 lines each (15 lines)
  - \* The poem must use three sound devices
  - \* The poem must use at least one form of figurative language

**BACK:** A list of the songs on your album. The song titles must be as follows:
